We meet at 6:30 p.m. the third Thursday of each month upstairs in the magazine corner. The next meeting will be August 15th. The book discussed in July was *The Honk and Holler Opening Soon*, by Billie Letts.

For the August discussion, we are now reading *The Guernsey Literary and Potato Peel Pie Society,* by Mary Ann Shaffer and Annie Barrows. January 1946: writer Juliet Ashton receives a letter from a stranger, a founding member of the Guernsey Literary and Potato Peel Pie Society. And so begins a remarkable tale of the island of Guernsey during the German occupation, and of a society as extraordinary as its name.

Copies of this book are widely available in the Sage Library System, as well as an audio book version. All readers are welcome (and for those of you wondering, No, you do not have to have a library card in order to join us), even if you haven't finished the book.
