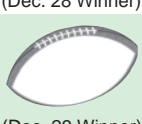

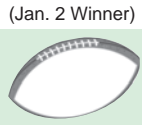

SURVIVOR Football Official Rules

1. Object of the game is to correctly select one winner from each DAY of the holiday college bowl games. Your correct picks must be CONSECUTIVE. It does not matter how many you ultimately get correct – only how long you can last without a miss. First miss and you're finished. Contestant who lasts the greatest number of days from among all contestants from all participating newspapers (or who survives a Tiebreaker system) wins the grand prize of \$10,000 – or \$1,000 if this winner had any misses, including tiebreakers. Write the number next to that school in the football corresponding to the day that game is played. Move on to the next day and repeat the process until you have placed one number in each of the footballs. Entries on which more than one number is written in any football will be disqualified. 4. Next, fill in the three Tiebreakers. Points scored by both teams in the Rose Bowl (without exceeding the total), point differential in this game (without exceeding the total) and total offensive yards from scrimmage by both teams in this game (closest to). In case of a tie for either the local or the grand prize, if the first Tiebreaker doesn't produce a winner, the second will be applied.
