A journey of a million bottles begins with a single grape....

And a dream, of course. Jill House, reflects on the journey that started almost 15 years ago when she started to make plans for what to do with her family's orchard, "I kept thinking about how much I love how wine brings people together and knew it was something I could do." Her dream started with 20 acres of grapes planted on the family's 100-year-old farm and has included the opening of our Hood River tasting room in 2016 and plans for a tasting room and lavender garden on the estate (planning to open early 2019).

Broken Boulder Vineyards, our estate vineyard located in the Hood River Valley and aptly named from the hundreds of boulders extracted before planting, currently produces Pinot Noir, Pinot Gris, and Chardonnay. The first estate wine, the Dorothy Rosé, was named after Jill's Grandma Dorothy. Jill laughs as she remembers Grandma asking her to lunch at the Columbia Gorge Hotel just so they could go drink wine together. "Her favorite color was pink, so I had to name our beautiful Rosé after her!" This award-winning wine is foot-stomped by Jill and other female relatives of Dorothy. "Only girl feet!" as Jill loves to say.

This Fall will bring two more estate wines to the list including our new reserve line, Artúr,

which is named after Jill's grandpa. Art was the inspiration for Jill to become a farmer and she loves to share stories of working with 'Gramps' packing and selling their Gravenstein apples when she was a little girl. "He was an innovator and was always thinking of how to make things better." As a special tribute, Jill dedicated her premium red blend, Quiver, to Gramps. This innovative blend contains Zinfandel, Merlot, Syrah, Tempranillo, and Barbera, and was awarded with a double gold at SavorNW.

Working with award-winning vintner Rich Cushman, and his 40 years of experience, has given Stave & Stone a reputation for quality. For varieties that can't grow on the estate, Rich and Jill work with local vineyards like Van Horn, Annala, and White Salmon to get high quality grapes. These grapes have been turned into a lineup of award-winning wines which continue to excite palettes of novice and skilled tasters alike. "I wanted to present the best wines possible. You have one shot for a good impression, and I wasn't going to squander it." Other wines currently on our tasting list include Riesling, Pinot Gris, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Cabernet with more varietals in the works. When you step into our tasting room, it's like

stepping into your best friend's living room. Friendly staff greets you and you can take a seat on our handcrafted wine barrel furniture or cozy up to the beautiful black granite bar. Jill's husband, partner, and biggest cheerleader, Kyle, is often found greeting old friends and new visitors. If you happen to come by on Wednesday evening, you will get to meet and greet with artists and performers from the local area. Our Meet the Artist series has included artists from culinary arts (with a gelato tasting), photography, jewelry, boutique clothing and gifts, soaps made with Stave & Stone wine, performing arts, and fiber arts. Weekends bring opportunities to listen to local musicians. The dance floor gets a lot of use when bands ranging in styles from Bluegrass to hot Jazz light up the stage. On your visit, make sure to order one of our eye-catching (and immense) cheese boards. Or for your sweet tooth, try our decadent dark chocolate and sea salt wine infused truffles - the perfect complement to any red wine. Plus, if you love to pair your wine with food, we offer a Legacy Tasting Experience where you'll meet our full line up paired with



the perfect small bite of scrumptious snacks. The food menu has several small plate options including an option for kids.

Jill has never forgotten the legacy that has gotten her to this point, which is why you'll see an archery theme running throughout the winery. The archery reference points to a family name of Fletcher. To fletch is to attach feathers to arrows. "Stave" in our name refers to the wooden length of an archer's bow, and also refers to the rib of a wine barrel. The Quiver blend adds to the theme by referring to the pouch arrows are placed in. The Fletcher family has been in the Hood River Valley for over 100 years, placing their 4th generation farm among the few Century Farms in the area.
